

## A peek inside...

**the Nursery-** a large and colorful room filled with everything that babies and toddlers need. We also have a cozy little room especially for nursing moms. All of our toys and equipment are completely sanitized every week and we carefully monitor each child from check-in to pick up. We even have a pager system to contact parents in the event of an emergency or other needs.

**the Preschool-** lots of really fun toys and creative hands-on crafts and games are waiting for your preschool-aged children. Individual classrooms are designed with little chairs and tables, colorfully decorated walls, and fun toys for ages two through kindergarten. We use a Bible-based curriculum that's just right for little ones to understand and learn about God on their own level.

**our Kids Church-** our classrooms are set up with all sorts of fun things for elementary students. During Kids Church students have an opportunity to learn about Jesus through dramas, videos, crafts, games, teaching times and small group activities. A number of extra-curricular events are also planned throughout the year such as bowling, gym nights, movie nights and more.

**AWANA-** a weekly club for K-6th grade students that focuses on Bible memorization through games, Bible stories and practice. They meet on Wednesday nights from 6:30 to 8pm. Twice a month they do a theme night such as *pajama night*, *twins night*, etc. Incentive awards are given throughout the year.

**CLUB MOM-** A program designed especially for Moms of children ages 0-12 yrs. They meet on the second Tuesday of each month (9-11am) to enjoy encouraging speakers, great food, fun crafts and a refreshing break from their children (the children ages 0-5 yrs. are cared for by trained volunteers during each session).

**OLD FASHIONED PICNIC-** a fun family celebration – sack races, egg launcher, face painting, pie eating contest, bingo, chicken barbeque and much more! Lots of fun for youngsters and oldsters too!

**FALL FESTIVAL-** a fun and safe place to bring the whole family on Halloween night. Activities include a *toddler fun zone*, train rides, a carnival games, live drama, a family photo booth, and *trunk-or-treat* for everyone (go car-to-car to find your treats in theme-decorated trunks).
